(D) Gentle Reminders:	
Climate:	<p>Hong Kong is situated in the sub-tropic region with temperate climate for half of the year.</p> <p>In spring (March till May), the average temperature ranges from 18°C to 25°C. In spring, the chance of rainfall increases, and humidity is usually higher than in autumn. Evenings can be cooling.</p> <p>In summer (June till August), the average temperature ranges from 26 °C to 32 °C. Though the weather is hot with rains quite often, thunderstorms and typhoon do occur. It is advisable for tourists to be prepared with raincoat or umbrella and wear short sleeve clothing.</p> <p>In autumn (September till November), the average temperature ranges from 20°C to 28°C. The weather is generally sunny, with less frequent rainfall. They are often considered the most pleasant months for tourists.</p> <p>In winter (December till February), the average temperature ranges from 15°C to 18°C and sky is usually cloudy. The temperature may drop till 8°C when there is strong wind. It is advisable for tourists to wear long sleeve clothing with big coat.</p>

a) Problem Solving Approach Study	<p>1st Meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher will provide practical examples and discuss with the assigned mentor on his area of concern in teaching. - Teacher will fix the second meeting and the content of learning - Assigned mentor will recommend reading materials - Arrangement will be made for the teacher to sit in during lectures where appropriate <p>2nd Meeting:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Assigned mentor to share possible solutions to the teacher's area of concern - Detailed discussion on the teacher's area of concern - Questions and feedback session <p>3rd Meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The teacher may inquire on his findings for the past two weeks and suggest solutions to the problems faced. - Assigned mentor will provide feedback on the teacher's findings and solutions.
b) Independent study	Using the resources in the library of University Of Hong Kong, the teacher undergoes independent study based on his area of concern. The teacher may seek advice from his assigned mentor during his second and third meeting.
c) Tour around school compounds, classroom observation	Visit to at least two schools with classroom observation and sharing sessions with the local principals and teachers.

Other activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Meeting with the assigned mentor ✓ Synopsis on the history of the University of Hong Kong ✓ Familiarise with the surroundings around the school compound (Food, Shopping, places of interest) ✓ Visit to the classrooms, lecture halls and other facilities (e.g. Cafeteria, library, book stores, stadium) ✓ Transport explanation(e.g. using MTR, public transport)
